

LEVEL 2 DIPLOMA FOR HAIR PROFESSIONALS -HAIRDRESSING

This qualification is designed for learners who are at least 16 years old and who wish to develop the skills and knowledge needed to begin to work as a Hairdresser. Learners wishing to complete these qualifications will be doing so as an employed, apprentice in a Salon environment.

END POINT ASSESSMENT:

A practical observation where the learner will demonstrate that they can complete a range of services on at least two models to industry standards and within commercial timings. Oral questioning where the learner's consultation skills, communication skills, safe working practices, professionalism, values, and behaviours will be assessed.

A Professional discussion which must last for 35 minutes. Your End-Point Assessor must ask at least six questions using your completed project as a reference for the discussion.

A knowledge test which is a computer-based test that consists of 40 multiple-choice questions and the apprentice will have 60 minutes to complete the test.

LEVEL 3 DIPLOMA FOR ADVANCED AND CREATIVE HAIR PROFESSIONALS

This qualification is designed for learners who wish to progress from a Level 2 qualification in Hairdressing and are looking to enhance and develop their creative skills and become a professional stylist. Learners wishing to complete these qualifications will be doing so as an employed, apprentice in a Salon environment.

MANDATORY UNITS:

Unit 301 Creatively restyle hair using a combination of techniques

Unit 302 Creatively style and dress hair

Unit 303 Creative hair colour correction services

Unit 304 Provide client consultation services

Unit 305 Smoothing and strengthening systems

Unit 306 Use fashion forward trends in hair to create a collection of hairstyle looks



END POINT ASSESSMENT:

Practical observation where the learner will demonstrate that they can undertake two services:

- 1. Create one precision haircut and finish from their personal collection of hair style looks.
- 2. Complete one advanced creative colour conversion service on previously coloured hair.

A professional discussion which will last for up to 45 minutes. Your End-Point Assessor must ask at least 8 questions. The questions will involve a focus on coverage of prior learning activities and problem solving and both parties may refer to the apprentice's collection of hairstyle looks to support the discussion.

A knowledge test which is a computer-based test that will consist of 40 multiple choice questions. Apprentices will have a maximum of 80 minutes to complete the test. The test must be passed prior to the Apprentice moving on the practical observation and professional discussion assessments.

LEVEL 3 NVQ DIPLOMA IN HAIRDRESSING

The Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Hairdressing is designed for learners who work in hairdressing industry and are wishing to update, develop and enhance their existing skill set. The Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Hairdressing provides the necessary skills and knowledge that prove occupational competence as a senior stylist.

Funding is available for this qualification in the form of an Advanced Learner Loan. If you are aged 19+ on the first day of your course and want to take a qualification from Level 3 – Level 6 at an approved Training Provider such as us at Hair@PA. A loan covers your course fees, if you are living in the UK and have done so for more than 3 years.

PRIVATE SHORT COURSES

ASSISTANT SHAMPOO TRAINING:

It is highly recommended that a salon assistant/Saturday workers hold a qualification from a regulated awarding organisation.

To assist Salons with this requirement for insurance purposes, we provide this short 1 day course to cover the NHBF knowledge skills and behaviours for assistants in shampooing, conditioning and treating the scalp.
